Squires Pond Southwell Town Council

NSDC Street Scene Proposal -

In conservation area planning application to be supplied.

Tree <u>0820</u> Willow DBH approx 1.2m, height approx 25m

Tree showing signs of limb failure throughout crown, due to potential weight in the lateral branches. A reduced amount of foliage within the top of the crown with visible signs of dead. Tree in striking distance of public footpath and open spaces.

Work recommended- reduction of overall crown to tree, removal of deadwood and any dangerous branches that pose a threat to the public.



Tree 0821 Willow, DBH approx 1.5m, height approx 28m

Tree in good condition with good foliage covering. Branches containing large amounts of weight with potential failure in the future. Signs of dead within the crown, tree within striking distance of public footpath and open spaces.

Work recommended- reduction in overall crown, removal of dead timber



Overhanging Limbs removed over footpath on far side beyond Play Area. STC To carry out Land Registry Check to identify owner and liaise as matter of urgency.

Pond Area

Willow trees within small woodland around Squires Pond. Approx height 10-20m, Outer trees within striking distance of football playing field and public car park. Numerous trees cracking within the main stems, with mixed amounts of growth. Failed trees hung up within neighbouring trees, posing a threat to the public.

Work recommended- selective felling and pollarding of both trees on the outer circle and within the pond. Removal of all trees that pose an imminent threat to the public with the potential to either monolith or fully remove. Monoliths too be left at between 3-5m to promote future growth. A management plan to be put in place to re-pollard on a frequent basis.
