### **Clerk and projects report**

### **General Maintenance**

All the skatepark works have been completed by Betong Park and handed over to STC as of last week.

Squires have some final Ground works to complete and then our Groundstaff can put the grass seed down. We have been in discussions with Skate Nottingham, Friends of Southwell Parks and the TE Committee regarding potential opening date of 06 May, although this date may slide due to unforeseen weather and some final groundworks which need to be competed. A decision on the opening date is due to be made early next week.

The 2nd grant instalment has been received and the final application for the grant funding has been applied for from FCC communities.

The first phase of Beryls meadow work has been completed.

The tractors have both been serviced.

The Fire alarm at the OCH has been serviced.

Staff First Aid at work training has been booked for 16 April at the OCH – 5 members of staff will be trained (LW, AB, BB, IV AO).

Preserva have submitted a breakdown of the quote and this included for discussion at FC.

The old workshop at WMRG has now been closed and the old toilet block is being used as storage and also the  $4^{th}$  garage behind the OCH.

Anti social behaviour is still ongoing in Church Street toilets and across the estate including the Market Square, WMRG and Norwood Garden. These are being reported daily to the beat officers.

Crime numbers have been obtained for some of the incidents and insurance claims have been started to replace the basket swing at Norwood and the roof on the climbing frame.

The website is being updated with all minutes and supporting papers going back to last April, almost complete.

Survey carried out with local businesses and new facebook "focus on" is proving successful and bringing in more traffic to the website and positive posts.

Stalls market is back 24/03 and monthly thereafter.

In talks with Classic Wise to assist with their opening events and a "joint" event.

We are working towards producing the end of year accounts.

All staff are trialling a new work scheduling app to track hours and log tasks.

Confirmed grants from NCC and NSDC for Skate Park opening event.
